

## **ESCAPE MANOR GUEST VACCINE PASSPORT POLICY (SASKATCHEWAN)**

### **Policy Overview**

Escape Manor is committed to taking meaningful precautions to protect its employees, contractors and guests from illness caused by COVID-19. Vaccination reduces the chance that a person will become severely ill if they contract COVID-19. This Policy applies to all Escape Manor locations in the Province of Saskatchewan.

### **Policy Details**

#### Vaccination Requirement

In accordance with provincial public health policy, **on or after October 1st, 2021**, any guest that wishes to enter an Escape Manor office or location, subject to the exceptions listed below in this Policy, must:

- Provide proof of identification and proof of being fully vaccinated; or
- Escape Manor must review and confirm the provided information.

“Fully vaccinated” means 14-days after receiving:

- The second of two doses of an mRNA vaccine (Pfizer, Moderna) or AstraZeneca/COVISHIELD (all interchangeable between the two doses), or
- 1 dose of Janssen (Johnson & Johnson) vaccine.

### **Proof of Identification**

In addition to proof of vaccination, guests will need to present proof of identification to enter Escape Manor. See Schedule A below for types of identification that are acceptable for this purpose.

### **Other Health Policies in Force**

All other provincial public health and workplace safety measures remain in effect (including but not limited to capacity limits, guest screening, masking, physical distancing and collection of guest contact information where required).

## Data Retention

Escape Manor will not retain any information provided by a guest that is required to show proof of identification or proof of vaccination under the current provincial health legislation.

## Exceptions

Proof of vaccination is not required for the following:

- Employees, contractors, repair workers, delivery workers, students, volunteers, inspectors or others who are entering the business or organization for work purposes and not as guests (*but note that the Escape Manor's Employee Covid-19 Vaccination Policy does apply to many of the foregoing classes of individuals*);
- A patron who is entering an indoor area solely for the following purposes:
  - to use a washroom;
  - to access an outdoor area that can only be accessed through an indoor route;
  - to make a retail purchase;
  - while placing or picking up an order
  - while paying for an order;
  - to purchase admission; or
  - as may be necessary for the purposes of health and safety.
- Children under 12 years of age (*but note that anyone accompanying the child that is over the age of 12 will need to provide proof of vaccination*).
- Proof of Negative Test
  - Individuals who do not have proof of vaccination have the option of providing proof of a negative COVID-19 test result from within the previous 72 hours.
  - Effective immediately the SHA will not be providing testing for asymptomatic individuals giving priority to those presenting with symptoms unless identified as a close contact, have had a positive rapid antigen test, identified as part of an outbreak situation or requiring transfer or admission to long-term care, primary care, social services or intensive care units.
  - A self-administered take-home rapid antigen test will not be accepted as valid proof of negative COVID-19 test results. Individuals requiring a negative test result have several private options on the market that will provide a rapid antigen test or a polymerase chain reaction (PCR) test for a fee.

All other public health measures (e.g., masking and physical distancing) continue to apply to patrons.

## Duration and Review

Escape Manor may update and revise this Policy at any time, without notice, but shall remain in effect until such time as Health Canada and the Ministry of Health rescind all public health regulations regarding the mandatory vaccination passport.

**Schedule A:**  
**Steps to Verify Vaccine Passport**

1. Distribute this Policy to all employees of Escape Manor and have them sign-off as having read and understood its terms.
2. Post a notice on the front door of every Escape Manor premises indicating that Saskatchewan's Mandatory Vaccine Passport is in effect.
3. Employees will confirm on confirmation calls that proof of vaccination and identification will be required at check-in for anyone over the age of 12.
4. At Check-In:
  - a. **Confirm that guests are symptom free** as per existing public health policy.
  - b. **Request paper-based or digital proof of full vaccination.** The following are acceptable in paper or digital form unless otherwise indicated:
    - i. Wallet cards received at time of immunization
    - ii. A printed copy of your MySaskHealthRecord (MSHR) vaccine certificate (with or without a QR code)
    - iii. A screenshot of your MSHR vaccine certificate (with or without a QR code) saved to your device
    - iv. An earlier version of your MSHR COVID-19 vaccine certificate
    - v. A COVID-19 vaccine printout from Saskatchewan Health Authority Public Health
    - vi. To come - A QR code/MySaskHealthRecord vaccine certificate uploaded to SK Vax Wallet
  - c. **Request proof of identification.** This must include the name and date of birth of the guest, which matches the vaccination receipt. Identification documents that may be used as proof of identification include:
    - i. Birth certificate
    - ii. Citizenship card
    - iii. Driver's licence
    - iv. Government (Saskatchewan or other) issued identification card, including health card
    - v. Indian Status Card /Indigenous Membership Card
    - vi. Passport
    - vii. Permanent Resident card

The identification requirements are flexible, and identification is required to confirm only the name of the person and date of birth – government identification can be used for this purpose but is not required. **The name and date of birth of the guest must match the proof of vaccination document.**
